

Call for Extended Abstracts

Undergraduate Research Day 2018

Therefore, Department calls for papers from the final year students who have conducted a research as a partial fulfillment of the degree program

Please refer following guidelines for preparing your extended abstracts;

- Submissions must be entirely original, not previously published, and must not be under concurrent consideration or schedule for presentation elsewhere.
- The extended abstract should provide under following headings;
 - **Introduction (Background of the Study, Problem Identification, Research Questions/Objectives and Significance of the Study)**
 - **Literature review**
 - **Methodology**
 - **Analysis and Discussion**
 - **Findings and Conclusion (Implications for theory and /or practice)**
- The submission should be arranged to following order
 - Paper title
 - Author information
 - 5 Keywords
 - Extended abstract (as per the above guidelines)
 - Figure/s (if any)
 - Acknowledgement/s
 - References
- Submission format
 - Paper Margins -1 inch / paper size – A4
 - Font type - Times New Roman/ font size – 12 / line space – 1.5
- Extended abstract submission should be **no more than 4 pages** excluding references
- Selection for inclusion in the conference proceedings will be based upon quality, originality determined by the reviewing process
- Accepted abstracts will be published in the “ Undergraduate Research Day 2018” conference proceedings
- Extended abstracts should be submitted to **public@sjp.ac.lk** on or before **31st March 2018**
- Sample extended abstract template is available in the Department
